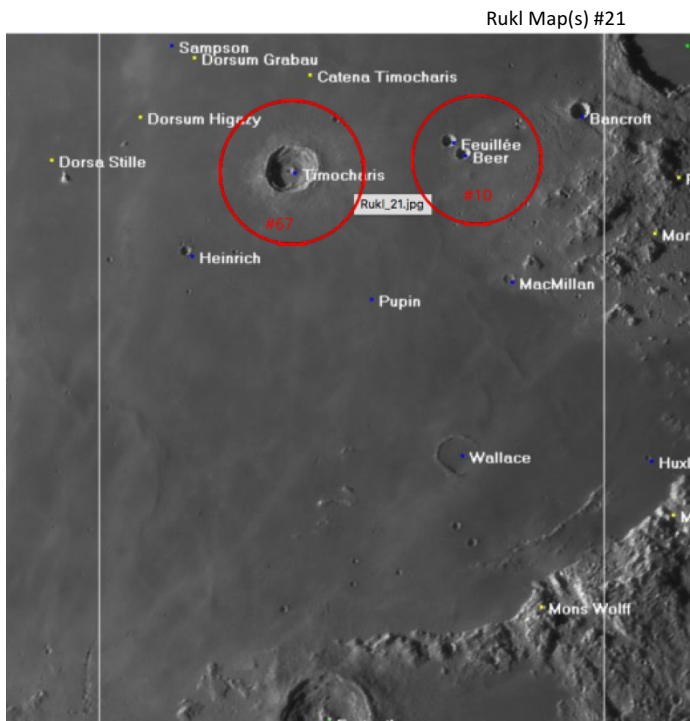


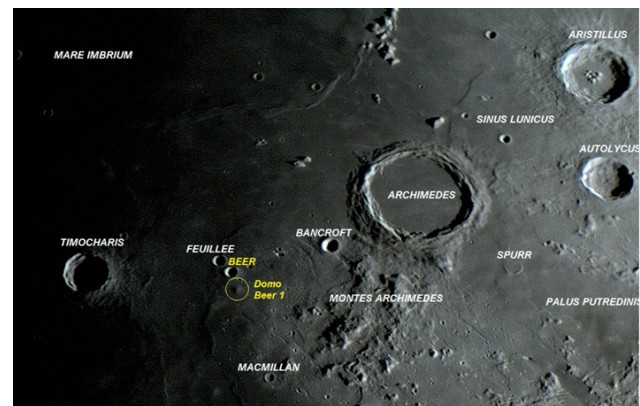
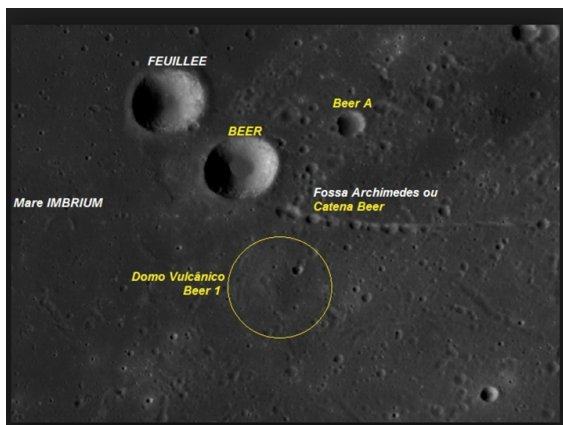
#010 Beer, Beer Catena & Feuillée

Beer is a relatively small lunar impact crater located on the Mare Imbrium, to the east of the crater Timocharis. Just to the northwest is the matching twin Feuillée.

Timocharis is a prominent [lunar impact crater](#) located on the [Mare Imbrium](#). The closest crater of comparable dimensions is [Lambert](#) to the west. The smaller craters [Feuillée](#) and [Beer](#) lie to the east of Timocharis.

The rim of Timocharis has a somewhat [polygonal](#) outline, with an outer [rampart](#) that extends over 20 kilometers in all directions. The interior wall is slumped and sharply terraced. The center of the floor is occupied by a craterlet that lies on a slight rise.
